
Darganfod Corwen

Exploring Corwen

Mae tref farchnad fechan Corwen wedi mwynhau statws uwch na'r disgwyl am ganrifoedd lawer. Gyda'i safle strategol wrth droed Mynyddoedd y Berwyn ger troad eang yn yr Afon Dyfrdwy, mae saint o'r chweched ganrif, byddinoedd goresgynnol ac amddiffynnol, porthmyn a theithwyr coetsis Fictoraidd wedi ymweld â'r dref yn eu tro.

Felly, mae'r "Groesffyrrd" hon yng Ngogledd Cymru wedi cael digon o ymarfer o ran croesawu teithwyr. Y dyddiau hyn, maent yn dod am y bwyd a diod, yr ymdeimlad o hanes ac i archwilio un o dirweddau gwarchodedig harddaf Prydain: AHNE Bryniau Clwyd a Dyffryn Dyfrdwy.

Mae Corwen yn dref sydd â Chroeso i Gerddwyr ac mae'r daith gylchol fer hon, gyda thaith ddewisol i fyny bryn Pen y Pigyn, yn fan cychwyn ardderchog. Mae Ffordd Gogledd y Berwyn, sy'n dringo'r mynyddoedd gwylt rhwng Corwen a Llangollen, yn dilyn mynydd oher.




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So this “Crossroads of North Wales” has had plenty of practice in welcoming travellers. Nowadays they come for the food and drink, for the sense of history and to explore one of Britain’s loveliest protected landscapes.

Corwen is a Walkers Are Welcome town and this short circular tour, with a detour up Pen y Pigyn hillside, is a great place to start. The North Berwyn Way, which climbs the wild mountains between Corwen and Llangollen, is a bit more of a challenge.

What makes it special?

Two words: Owain Glyndŵr. You won't get far in Corwen or the surrounding area without finding reminders of the last native-born Prince of Wales.

You certainly can't miss the life-size statue of Owain astride his battle horse in The Square - right opposite the hotel that bears his name. Three miles to the east at Llidiart-y-Parc is the mound from which he launched his revolt against English rule.

Corwen is the ancestral home of Wales's national hero, the mythic figure who's said to lie sleeping until his country's greatest need. Now part of the Clwydian Range and Dee Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, it remains a landscape fit for heroes.

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Cae'r Drewwyn is the most southerly of a spectacular chain of Iron Age hillforts stretching right across the Glyndwr range in North East Wales.

Trofach i'r cwtch wrth myfyl Ty'r Egwys ac eu hanes wrthol o'r godedr dyrrawd o'r trwynedd o'r ardal amgylchedig a gwyliau gwyr.

Caer Drewwyn was built in 1000 BC above sea level to dominate Powys's north east skyline.

Mynydd Gwerni is a prominent hillfort situated just below Cae'r Drewwyn, and features some of the best preserved fortifications in Wales.

Eisteddfa Bryn Celyn is another well-preserved hillfort located near the village of Llangebby.

Gredyddau Bryn Celyn is a hillfort located in the northern part of the county, near the village of Gredyddau.

Dyffryn Clwyd is the area where the River Clwyd flows through the county.

Glan Clwyd is the area where the River Clwyd meets the Irish Sea.

Glan Glyn is the area where the River Glyn meets the River Clwyd.

Glan Mawddach is the area where the River Mawddach meets the River Clwyd.

Glan Tanat is the area where the River Tanat meets the River Clwyd.

Glan Teifi is the area where the River Teifi meets the River Clwyd.

Glan Ystwyth is the area where the River Ystwyth meets the River Clwyd.

Glyndwr's Way is a long-distance walking route in North East Wales.

Hen Orsedd is a castle in Denbighshire, Wales.
